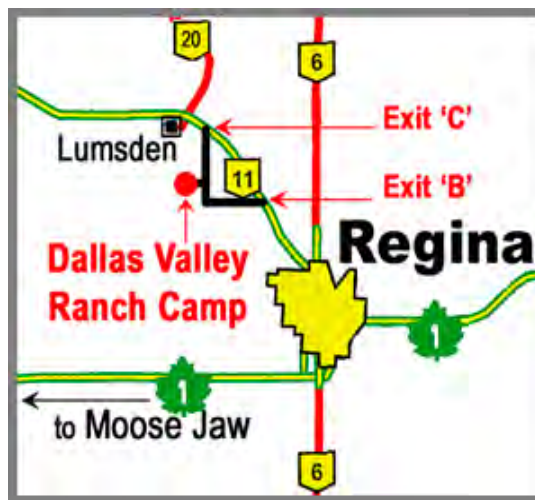

Riding Club

Fun way to make friends and learn horse care and riding skills with other kids from camp! The Dallas Valley Riding Club will run weekly with a maximum of twelve students per group.

The students will learn and/or build on the skills of:

- horse care and safety
- saddling and bridling
- basic to higher-level riding
- the various horse disciplines
- communication with other riders
- fun group horse games!

The above will be accomplished through **riding lessons**, on camp horses, and **book meetings** in which kids will complete horse information books, therefore expanding their skills to be able to communicate with other horse people. They may have chances to attend other equine functions with their group. Additionally, students will have opportunity to participate in an Achievement Day at the end of the school year to show off their new skills!

*Each Dallas Valley Riding Club meeting will include a devotional, a camp-style challenge that will encourage the students to learn and grow in their knowledge of and relationship with Jesus Christ.



Riding Club Schedule:

First session:

Week of Sep. 20th to Week of Dec. 10th
(12 weeks) for \$240.00

Tuesdays: Ages 15-18 (6:00PM)

Wednesdays: Ages 13-14 (6:00PM)

Thursdays: Ages 11-12 (6:00PM, 7:30PM)

Second Session:

February-May plus an Achievement Day in June.

Instructors:

Danielle Lees

She has been teaching riding lessons since 2004 and a riding instructor at Dallas Valley since 2006. She has experience with 4-H, training horses and showing.

Tanis Klippenstine

She has been the Riding Director at Dallas Valley since 2001. She led a 4-H Light Horse Club for three years, has experience training horses and barrel racing, both in the Saskatchewan Barrel Racing Association and Canadian Cowboys Association rodeos.

Individual/Group

Riding Lessons

Individual or group lessons offer more intensive, one-on-one training for riding students. These lessons can focus on basics or more advanced riding, horse training, and disciplines such as reining and barrel racing. These would be especially helpful for students who already own horses and wish to take a step ahead with their horsemanship.

* Also, children between of the ages of 9 and 10 can take shorter, less expensive private or group lessons before joining the Riding Club. Contact for details.

Individual/Group lessons will take place on Saturdays or pre-arranged weekdays.

Fees:

Four one-hour lesson packages:

\$160.00 (individual lessons)

\$140.00 (each, two person group lessons)

\$120.00 (each, three person group lessons)

\$100.00 (each, four person group lessons)

*The above costs cover the use of Dallas Valley Ranch Camp horses. Students who wish to bring their own horses to lessons may contact the camp and receive a \$20 discount per lesson package.

*Private/Group lesson fees must be paid by the first of the four one-hour lessons, and there will be no refund for missed lessons.
