Accommodations

- We have great accommodations in our lodge, each room has one queen size bed, a washroom with shower, a chest of drawers, and a place to hang clothing. Depending on the size of the room, there is also a bunk bed or a trundle bed.
- Families generally stay together. If you come alone, you may have a roommate.
- Some team members will stay in cabins (which also have a washroom and queen size bed). If you wish to bring a camper trailer to stay in, please contact the office.
- You are required to clean your room before leaving, supplies are provided to clean your room at the end of your stay. This way it is ready the next volunteer.
- **Due to health and safety concerns, we do not allow pets to be brought to camp.**

Positions

Main Camp

NURSE (2 per week)

A current RN, LPN or EMT is required. The nurse lives in the medical centre and provides 24 hour-a-day response to sickness and accidents among campers and leaders.

SKILL INSTRUCTORS(2 per week)

Provide a safe environment for campers to learn the use of either rifles or bows. They are also responsible for the care of equipment. Must have PAL to be Riflery instructor.

CUSTODIAN (3 per week)

Housekeeping, garbage disposal, care of the camp grounds, and maintenance of equipment are some of the responsibilities of the custodian.

MAINTENANCE (1 per week)

To assist with basic repairs around camp and lawn care such as mowing and trimming.

OFFICE ASSISTANT (4 month position)

This person must have good organizational ability, basic computer and typing skills. They must display good interpersonal and communication skills. Duties are clerical.

HEAD COOK (2 per week)

(Must be Food-Safe Certified)

Duties include overseeing all food preparation, delegating tasks, serving meals punctually, and fostering a productive and fun atmosphere. About 200 people are served daily at Main camp, about 90 people are served at Conestoga and 30 people at Adventure point.

ASSISTANT COOK (9 per week)

Must have a willing attitude, take instruction well, and perform basic food preparation with some guidance.



Services

- Lounge
- Free T-Shirt
- Laundry facilities (preferably for those staying longer periods of time but available if needed)
- Tuck (Canteen)
 - Tuck is in the lounge where there is also a sheet to keep track of your purchases.
 - Volunteers receive \$15.00 in free tuck during their week.
 - Paid support personelle will have tuck deducted off their pay.

Arrival & Departure

Arrival time may vary on role, all positions will need to be at camp the morning of the start of the camp week.

Departure on the last day of camp is shortly after lunch, as soon as the last of your duties are completed for the week.

What to Bring

- Indoor footwear—no outdoor shoes are permitted in any of the main buildings (**All cooks must have indoor closed-toe shoes**).
- Bedding/pillows/linens
- Toiletries/alarm clock
- Fan (ceiling fans are in all Lodge rooms-bring an extra fan if you'd like)
- Bible
- Swimsuit

Requirements

All Support team applicants must do the following to be a part of the One Hope team at Dallas Valley Ranch Camp:

- Complete the application form.
 - Complete a Criminal Record Check (must be updated every two years).
 - Regina residents can have this done at the City of Regina Police.
 - If you live outside Regina, go to your local RCMP detachment.
 - Read and sign the Code of Conduct and Statement of Faith @ (<https://www.dallasvalley.com/code-of-conduct>).
 - Watch the In-Safe Hands training video on your first day of work during summer.(Every year)
